WHEN: July 17-21

DESCRIPTION: Learn how to cut out a pattern, follow instructions and create masterpieces!

WHAT TO BRING: One and a half yards of coordinating fleece (1 1/2 yd. of 2 fabrics) for a fleece throw. Also Simplicity pattern 1520. Choice of shorts or lounge pants. Enough fabric for garment of choice - fleece, flannel or cotton-washed, dried, and ironed (if needed). One spool of white thread and package of 1" wide elastic.
